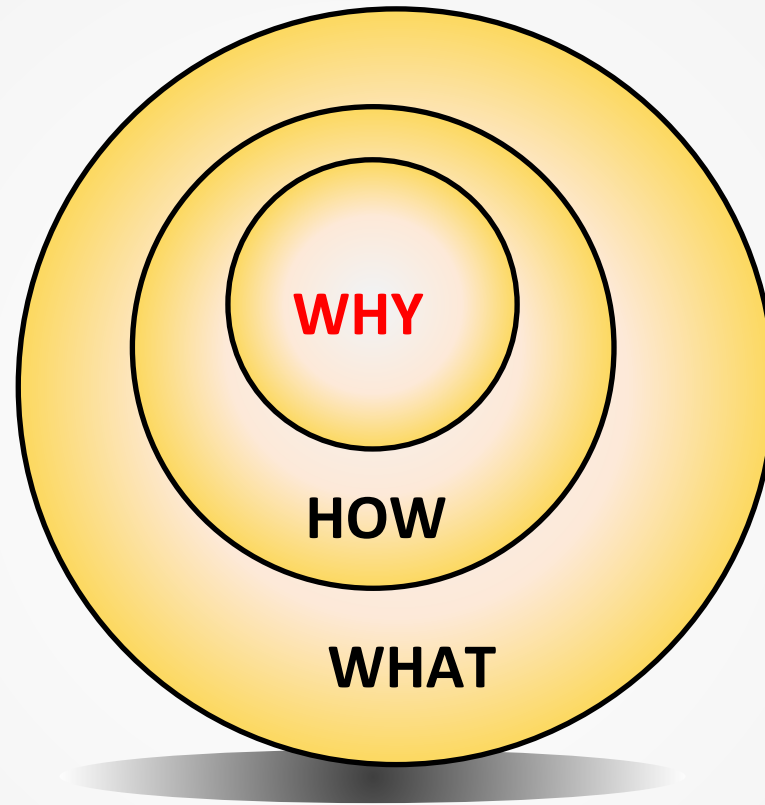

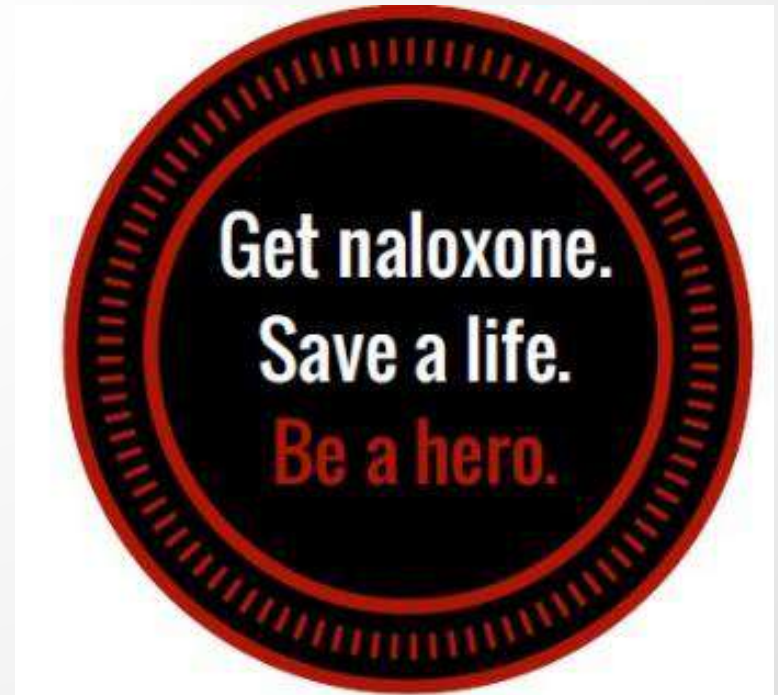
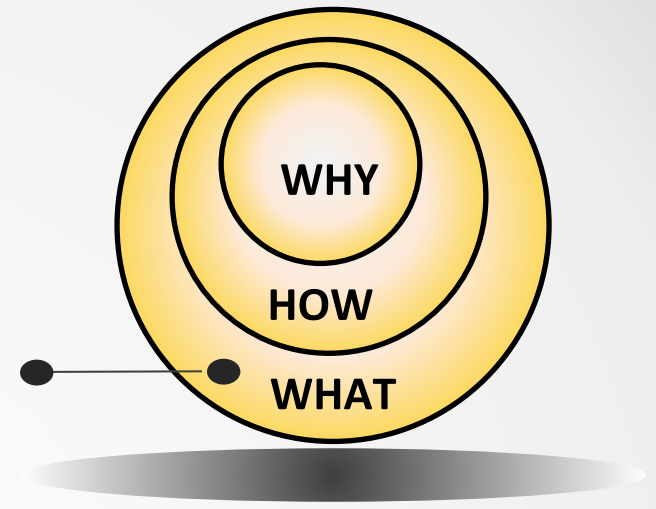

# The Golden Circle – Simon Sinek

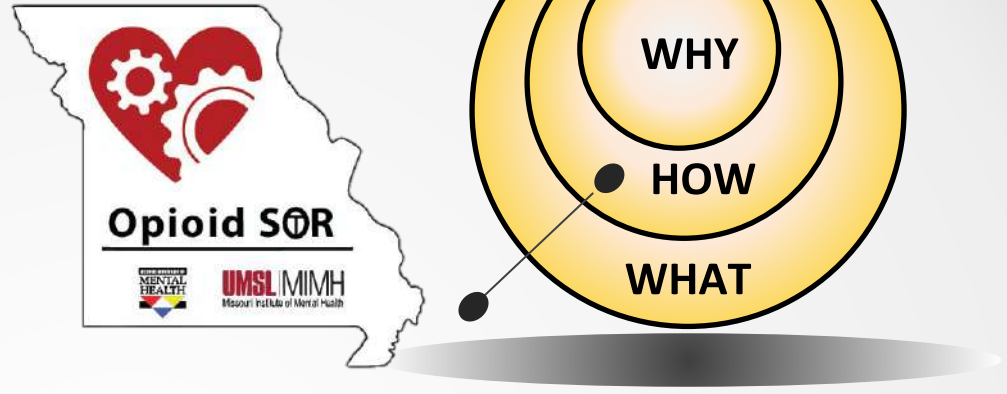
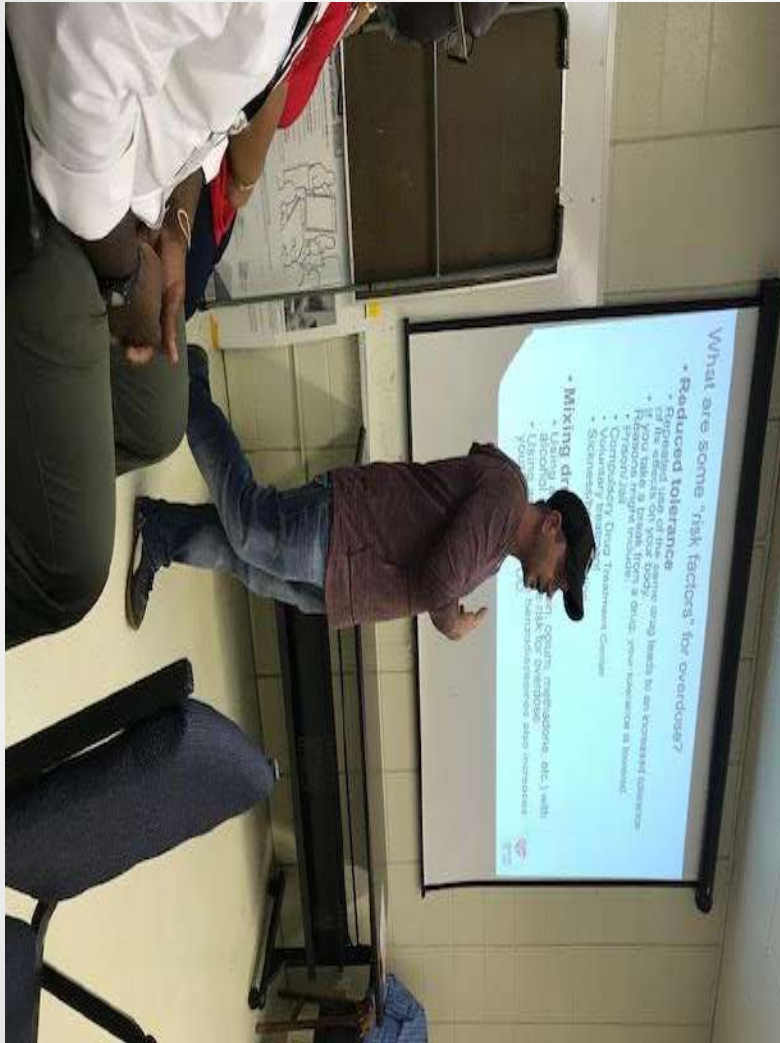


# Mo' Heroes – The What

  - Re-entry Agencies



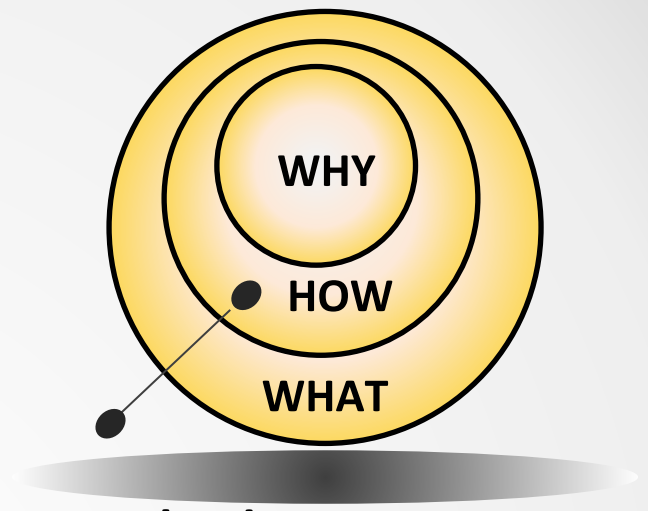
# Mo' Heroes – The How

  - Harm reductionists and people with lived experience



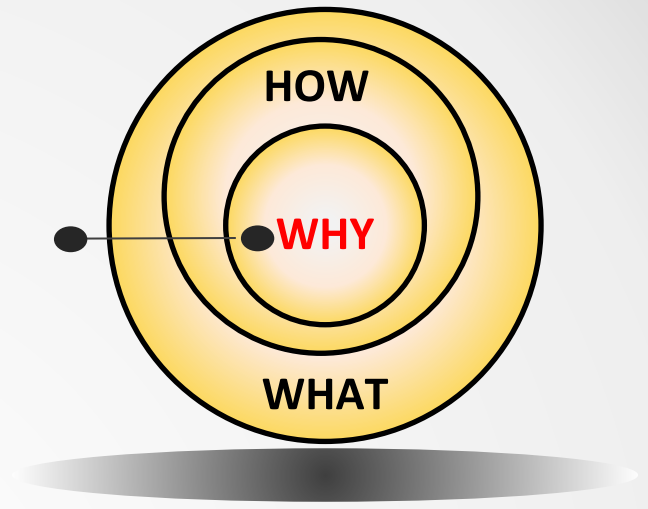
# Mo' Heroes – The How
